## House Bill 4058

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Amends 40-40-20 education goals to include apprenticeship programs registered with State Apprenticeship and Training Council.

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- 2 Relating to apprenticeship programs in Oregon's education mission; amending ORS 351.009.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - **SECTION 1.** ORS 351.009 is amended to read:
  - 351.009. The Legislative Assembly declares that the mission of all education beyond high school in Oregon includes achievement of the following by 2025:
  - (1) Ensure that at least 40 percent of adult Oregonians have earned a bachelor's degree or higher;
  - (2) Ensure that at least 40 percent of adult Oregonians have earned an associate's degree, completed an apprenticeship program that is registered with the State Apprenticeship and Training Council or earned a post-secondary credential as their highest level of educational attainment; and
  - (3) Ensure that the remaining 20 percent or less of all adult Oregonians have earned a high school diploma, an extended or modified high school diploma or the equivalent of a high school diploma as their highest level of educational attainment.

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
