

# House Bill 4074

Sponsored by Representatives JENSON, GREENLICK; Representatives CAMERON, HUFFMAN, KENNEMER, OLSON, RICHARDSON, WEIDNER, WHITSETT (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Board of Medical Imaging to waive specified licensing requirements for individual who meets certain criteria.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to medical imaging; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2014 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 688.405 to**  
5 **688.605.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The Board of Medical Imaging may waive the requirements listed in ORS**  
7 **688.455 (1)(b) for an individual who:**

8 (a) **Has 10 years' experience practicing the medical imaging modality for which the waiver**  
9 **is sought; and**

10 (b) **Performs that medical imaging modality as an employee of, or under a contract with,**  
11 **a hospital that has been designated as a Critical Access Hospital by the United States De-**  
12 **partment of Health and Human Services on or before the effective date of this 2014 Act.**

13 (2) **An individual who seeks a waiver under subsection (1) of this section must demon-**  
14 **strate to the board that enforcement of ORS 688.455 (1)(b) would result in the substantial**  
15 **shortage of the availability of the medical imaging modality for which the waiver is sought.**

16 (3) **The board may condition the issuance of a waiver under subsection (1) of this section**  
17 **by prescribing the terms of the waiver, including the duration of the waiver and any super-**  
18 **visory requirements that the board deems necessary for the individual to practice the med-**  
19 **ical imaging modality for which the waiver is sought.**

20 **SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
21 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect**  
22 **on its passage.**
