

House Bill 4099

Sponsored by Representative HICKS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Justice to conduct study on laws of this state that would need to be amended if people of this state vote to legalize marijuana at next regular general election held throughout this state.

Sunset on date of convening of 2015 regular session of Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to marijuana; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Justice shall conduct a study on the laws of this state**
5 **that would need to be amended in the event that the people of this state vote to legalize**
6 **marijuana at the next regular general election held throughout this state on November 4,**
7 **2014.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2014 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015**
9 **regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
