

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4110

- 1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 2, after “care” delete the rest of the line and
2 delete line 3 and insert a period.
- 3 Delete lines 5 through 7.
- 4 In line 9, delete the comma and insert a colon and begin a new paragraph and insert “(a)”.
- 5 After line 10, insert:
- 6 “(b) ‘Supervisory authority’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 144.087.”.
- 7 In line 14, delete “county sheriff’s office” and insert “local supervisory authority”.
- 8 In line 16, delete “county”.
- 9 Delete line 17 and insert “local supervisory authority; or”.
- 10 In line 18, delete “who”.
- 11 Delete line 19 and insert “or a local supervisory authority, if the employee or contractor meets
12 the credentialing criteria of the health benefit plan.”.
- 13 In line 21, delete “county sheriff’s office” and insert “local supervisory authority”.
- 14 In line 22, after “than” delete the rest of the line and delete line 23 and insert “115 percent of
15 the Medicare rate for the service or supply.”.
- 16 On page 2, line 4, delete “county sheriff’s office” and insert “local supervisory authority”.
- 17 In line 6, delete “out-of-network” and insert “in-network”.
- 18 In line 9, delete “county sheriff’s office” and insert “local supervisory authority”.
- 19 In line 10, delete “and”.
- 20 In line 12, delete “county sheriff’s office” and insert “local supervisory authority”.
- 21 In line 13, delete the period and insert “;
- 22 “(f) Limit coverage of hospital and ambulatory surgical center services provided to an insured
23 in the custody of a local supervisory authority to services provided by in-network hospitals and
24 ambulatory surgical centers; and
- 25 “(g) Reimburse an out-of-network renal dialysis facility at either the in-network or the out-of-
26 network rate paid by the insurer for dialysis provided to an insured in the custody of a local su-
27 pervisory authority.
- 28 “(5)(a) An insurer may not refuse to credential a health care provider who is an employee or
29 contractor of a county or a local supervisory authority on the basis that the employee or contractor
30 provides the services in a facility operated by the local supervisory authority.
- 31 “(b) If an insurer refuses to credential a health care provider who is an employee or contractor
32 of a county or a local supervisory authority, the insurer must give written notice to the provider
33 explaining the reasons for the refusal.”.
- 34 In line 14, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.
- 35 In line 20, delete “(6)” and insert “(7)”.

1 In line 21, delete “county sheriff’s office” and insert “local supervisory authority”.
2 Delete lines 22 through 45 and delete pages 3 through 5 and insert:
3 **“SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2014 Act applies to claims for reimbursement of health**
4 **services that are provided on or after January 1, 2015.”.**
