

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1506

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 3, insert:

3 **“INTERSTATE COMPACT ON EDUCATIONAL**
4 **OPPORTUNITY FOR MILITARY CHILDREN”.**
5

6 On page 2, line 29, delete “the Department of Education” and insert “a local school district”.

7 On page 3, after line 6, insert:

8 “P. ‘State education agency’ means the Department of Education.”.

9 In line 7, delete “P.” and insert “Q.”.

10 In line 9, delete “Q.” and insert “R.”.

11 In line 13, delete “R.” and insert “S.”.

12 In line 16, delete “S.” and insert “T.”.

13 On page 15, after line 34, insert:

15 **“ESTABLISHING NEW STATE COUNCIL**
16 **“(Establishment, Duties, Appointment, Term,**
17 **Confirmation, Per Diem)**

19 **“SECTION 2. (1) There is established a State Council for Educational Opportunity for**
20 **Military Children as described in Article VIII of the Interstate Compact on Educational Op-**
21 **portunity for Military Children under section 1 of this 2014 Act consisting of seven members**
22 **appointed by the Governor.**

23 **“(2) The term of office of each member is four years, but a member serves at the pleas-**
24 **ure of the Governor. Before the expiration of the term of a member, the Governor shall ap-**
25 **point a successor whose term begins on July 1 next following. A member is eligible for**
26 **reappointment. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make an appointment**
27 **to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.**

28 **“(3) The appointment of a member to the State Council is subject to confirmation by the**
29 **Senate in the manner prescribed in ORS 171.562 and 171.565.**

30 **“(4) A member of the State Council who is not a member of the Legislative Assembly is**
31 **entitled to compensation and expenses as provided in ORS 292.495.**

32 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding the term of office specified by section 2 of this 2014**
33 **Act, of the members first appointed to the State Council:**

34 **“(a) One shall serve for a term ending July 31, 2015.**

35 **“(b) One shall serve for a term ending July 31, 2016.**

1 Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children may adopt rules necessary for the
2 administration of the laws that the State Council is charged with administering.

3
4 “(Oaths, Witnesses, Subpoenas)

5
6 “**SECTION 8.** The State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children, the
7 director of the State Council and authorized representatives of the State Council may ad-
8 minister oaths, take depositions and issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses
9 and the production of documents or other written information necessary to carry out the
10 provisions of sections 2 to 9 of this 2014 Act. If any person fails to comply with a subpoena
11 issued under this section or refuses to testify on matters on which the person lawfully may
12 be interrogated, the procedure set out in ORS 183.440 shall be followed to compel obedience.

14 “(Advisory and Technical Committees)

15
16 “**SECTION 9.** (1) The State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children may
17 establish such advisory and technical committees as it considers necessary to aid and advise
18 the State Council in the performance of its functions. These committees may be continuing
19 or temporary committees. The State Council shall determine the representation, member-
20 ship, terms and organization of the committees and shall appoint their members.

21 “(2) Members of the committees are not entitled to compensation, but at the discretion
22 of the State Council may be reimbursed from funds available to the State Council for actual
23 and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their offi-
24 cial duties, in the manner and amount provided in ORS 292.495.

26 “MISCELLANEOUS

28 “**SECTION 10.** The unit captions used in this 2014 Act are provided only for the conven-
29 ience of the reader and do not become part of the statutory law of this state or express any
30 legislative intent in the enactment of this 2014 Act.

31 “**SECTION 11.** This 2014 Act is repealed on December 31, 2019.”.
