

# Senate Bill 1507

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for various public safety purposes.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon State Police for troopers in counties for which Governor has declared fiscal emergency.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:**

- (1) **Criminal Justice Division**  
**Operations..... \$ 1,100,000**
- (2) **Criminal Justice Division**  
**Organized Crime Section ..... \$ 1,900,000**
- (3) **Criminal Justice Division**  
**TITAN Fusion Center ..... \$ 600,000**
- (4) **Internet Crimes Against**  
**Children Task Force ..... \$ 1,200,000**
- (5) **Grants to district attorneys**  
**and sheriffs in counties for which**  
**Governor has declared fiscal**  
**emergency under ORS 203.095 .. \$ 1,200,000**

**SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon State Police, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,200,000, which may be expended for state troopers in counties for which the Governor has declared fiscal emergency under ORS 203.095.**

**SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.**
