CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to children’s health care coverage; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall investigate whether, and under what terms and conditions, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services is likely to approve matching funds from the federal Children’s Health Insurance Program for state expenditures used to subsidize the costs of health insurance provided by a commercial insurer to a child who is eligible for the Health Care for All Oregon Children program, established by ORS 414.231, if the child’s family income is from 200 percent to 300 percent of the federal poverty guidelines.

(2) The authority shall report its findings from the investigation and any recommendations for legislation, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the Senate Interim Committee on Health Care and Human Services no later than September 15, 2014.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2014 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.

SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.
