

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1562

1 In line 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line and insert
2 “creating new provisions; amending ORS 743A.082; and declaring an emergency.”.

3 After line 18, insert:

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) Each agency of this state shall provide to the executive director of the**
5 **Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation, without undue delay, any reports or**
6 **findings resulting from an independent review, investigation or audit of the development,**
7 **implementation or quality control of the health insurance exchange, conducted on or after**
8 **October 1, 2013, if the review, investigation or audit is contracted for or paid for, in whole**
9 **or in part, by an agency of this state.**

10 **“(2) The Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation board of directors or the execu-**
11 **tive director shall make publicly available and upon request to any person, without undue**
12 **delay, any reports or findings:**

13 **“(a) Provided to the executive director under subsection (1) of this section.**

14 **“(b) Resulting from an independent review, investigation or audit of the development,**
15 **implementation or quality control of the health insurance exchange, conducted on or after**
16 **October 1, 2013, if the review, investigation or audit is contracted for or paid for, in whole**
17 **or in part, by the corporation.**

18 **“SECTION 3. The executive director of the Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corpo-**
19 **ration shall appear before the Interim House Committee on Health Care and the Interim**
20 **Senate Committee on Health Care and Human Services, at the first meeting of each com-**
21 **mittee following adjournment sine die of the 2014 regular session of the Legislative Assembly,**
22 **to present an updated business plan for the future of the health insurance exchange. The**
23 **updated business plan must include, but is not limited to:**

24 **“(1) Demographic information about the individuals who have enrolled in qualified health**
25 **plans through the exchange;**

26 **“(2) The number of individuals enrolled in qualified health plans through the exchange**
27 **who have paid premiums, both subsidized and unsubsidized; and**

28 **“(3) Adjustments to the fees and charges described in ORS 741.105, or other administra-**
29 **tive changes, necessary for the corporation to be self-sustaining.**

30 **“SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 743A.082 by section 1 of this 2014 Act become op-**
31 **erative January 1, 2015.**

32 **“SECTION 5. Section 3 of this 2014 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the**
33 **2015 regular session of the Legislative Assembly.**

34 **“SECTION 6. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
35 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect**

1 **on its passage.”**

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
