

Senate Bill 5702

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits expenditures from federal funds collected or received by Department of Transportation for public safety broadband planning for six-year period beginning July 1, 2013.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,148,448 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Transportation for public safety broadband planning.

SECTION 2. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.
