

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5702

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

March 7

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the first semicolon insert “creating new provisions; amending
2 section 6, chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 10 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
5 \$237,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for
6 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Trans-
7 portation for public safety broadband planning.**

8 **“SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
9 expenditures established by section 1 (2)(c), chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, for a six-year
10 period beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
11 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and
12 federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for
13 Public Utility Commission Building exterior replacement is increased by \$2,147,920.**

14 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
15 established by section 1 (2)(a), chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, for a six-year period beginning
16 July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other re-
17 venues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, col-
18 lected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for HVAC
19 improvement projects is decreased by \$947,920.**

20 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
21 established by section 1 (2)(g), chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, for a six-year period beginning
22 July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other re-
23 venues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, col-
24 lected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Executive
25 Building renovation is decreased by \$500,000.**

26 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
27 established by section 1 (2)(c), chapter 615, Oregon Laws 2011, for a six-year period beginning
28 July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other re-
29 venues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, col-
30 lected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for fire panel
31 upgrades is decreased by \$700,000.**

32 **“SECTION 3.** Section 6, chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

33 **“Sec. 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are estab-
34 lished for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses
35 under this section from bond proceeds and other revenues, including federal funds, collected or re-

1 ceived by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for the acquisition
2 of and improvements to land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, fur-
3 nishing and equipping of buildings and facilities at community colleges:

6 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
 7 **\$1,630,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit**
 8 **for payment of expenses from lottery bond proceeds collected or received by the Department**
 9 **of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for the Central Oregon Community**
 10 **College Cascades Hall termination of Oregon State University leasehold, reacquisition of un-**
 11 **encumbered fee simple ownership, and remodel.**

12 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**
 13 **expenditures established by section 1 (3)(a), chapter 615, Oregon Laws 2011, for a six-year**
 14 **period beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
 15 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds, but excluding**
 16 **lottery funds, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department for The Dalles Read-**
 17 **iness Center is increased by \$8,000,000.**

18 **“SECTION 6. The Legislative Assembly approves the proposal of the Oregon Military**
 19 **Department, submitted in accordance with ORS 396.515 (4), for the sale of the Oregon Mili-**
 20 **tary Academy/Regional Training Institute building.**

21 **“SECTION 7. The project approval and expenditure limitation established by section 2 (3),**
 22 **chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for the Oregon State Police for the Oregon Wireless Inter-**
 23 **operability Network expires on June 30, 2014.**

24 **“SECTION 8. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
 25 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect**
 26 **on its passage.”.**
