

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4108**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 12 through 19 and insert:

2 “(2) The Oregon Health Authority shall contract with one or more
3 nonprofit organizations to operate a pilot project to test whether the au-
4 thority and coordinated care organizations can achieve good outcomes for
5 individuals who receive medical assistance by reusing durable medical
6 equipment in a safe, functionally appropriate and cost-effective manner. The
7 pilot project does not supplant the durable medical equipment coverage pro-
8 vided by the medical assistance program. The pilot project shall serve re-
9 cipients of medical assistance who reside in Washington, Multnomah,
10 Clackamas, Marion and Polk Counties. The pilot project may be expanded
11 as the authority deems appropriate.”

12 On page 2, line 7, before the colon insert “, acting in accordance with
13 quality standards adopted by the authority, have the responsibility to”.

14 In line 10, after “provide” insert “timely”.

15 Delete line 12 and insert:

16 “(e) Limits of liability comparable to other providers of services to med-
17 ical assistance recipients.

18 “(4) The authority shall develop and collect data, including feedback from
19 coordinated care organizations, consumers and health care providers, and
20 analyze the data to assess the success”.

21 In line 28, delete “January 2” and insert “April 20”.
