PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1579

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 17 and insert:

"SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, 'synchronization plan' means a plan developed by a patient who takes prescription drugs on a long-term basis, the patient's health practitioners and a pharmacist to align the refill dates for the patient's prescription drugs so that the drugs may be refilled on the same date.

- "(2) A health benefit plan, as defined in ORS 743.730, and a self-insured health plan, offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board or the Oregon Educators Benefit Board, that provide coverage of prescription drugs shall reimburse the cost of a refill of any covered drug prescribed in accordance with a synchronization plan.
- "(3) A health benefit plan may exclude a prescription drug from a synchronization plan if aligning the refills of the prescription drug with the refills of the patient's other prescription drugs would be unreasonably costly."
