## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1521

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line.
- In line 3, delete "87.010; appropriating money;".
- Delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 8 and insert:
- 5 "SECTION 1. (1) The Work Group on Commercial Interior Design
- 6 Registration is established, consisting of the following 10 members
- 7 appointed by the Governor:
- 8 "(a) A member who represents Interior Design Collaborative-Oregon
- 9 from among individuals nominated by Interior Design Collaborative-
- 10 Oregon;
- 11 "(b) A member who represents the International Interior Design
- 12 Association, and who specializes in commercial interior design, from
- 13 among individuals nominated by the International Interior Design
- 14 Association;
- 15 "(c) A member who represents the American Society of Interior
- 16 Designers, and who specializes residential interior design, from among
- 17 individuals nominated by the American Society of Interior Designers;
- 18 "(d) A member who represents the State Board of Architect Exam-
- 19 iners:
- 20 "(e) A member who represents the State Landscape Architect
- 21 Board;

"(f) A member who represents the State Board of Examiners for

- 1 Engineering and Land Surveying;
- 2 "(g) A member who is a contractor as defined in ORS 701.005;
- 3 "(h) A member who is a building official as defined in ORS 455.715;
- "(i) A member who is a student or educator in the field of commercial interior design; and
- "(j) A member who is a small business owner who is engaged in the practice of commercial interior design and who has not passed the National Council for Interior Design Qualification examination.
- "(2) The work group shall investigate, and may make recommendations for legislation on, the development of licensing or registration standards for those practicing commercial interior design.
- 12 "(3) A majority of the members of the work group constitutes a 13 quorum for the transaction of business.
- 14 "(4) Official action by the work group requires the approval of a 15 majority of the members of the work group.
- 16 "(5) The work group shall elect one of its members to serve as 17 chairperson.
- 18 "(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make 19 an appointment to become immediately effective.
- "(7) The work group shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the work group.
- 23 "(8) The work group may adopt rules necessary for the operation 24 of the work group.
- "(9) The work group shall submit a report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to small business no later than February 1, 2015.
- 29 "(10) Members of the work group are not entitled to compensation 30 and may not be reimbursed for travel or other expenses.

"(11) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, 1 are directed to assist the work group in the performance of its duties 2 and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to 3 furnish such information and advice as the members of the work 4 group consider necessary to perform their duties.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2014 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2015 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.

"SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.".
