

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1508**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the  
2 rest of the line.

3 In line 3, delete “and 181.812;”.

4 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 8 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Sex Offender Registration is**  
6 **established, consisting of five members as follows:**

7 **“(a) The Superintendent of State Police or the superintendent’s**  
8 **designee.**

9 **“(b) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from**  
10 **among members of the Senate.**

11 **“(c) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one**  
12 **member from among members of the House of Representatives.**

13 **“(d) The Governor shall appoint two members as follows:**

14 **“(A) One member of the Oregon State Sheriffs’ Association; and**

15 **“(B) One member of the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police.**

16 **“(2) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task**  
17 **force are nonvoting members of the task force and may act in an ad-**  
18 **visory capacity only.**

19 **“(3) The task force shall:**

20 **“(a) Examine alternative methods and models for sex offender reg-**  
21 **istration, particularly those used in the State of Washington and any**  
22 **other state, and including an online self-reporting system;**

1       **“(b) Examine the possibility of creating a system in which a visitor**  
2 **to a school within this state would be required to obtain a visitor’s**  
3 **badge, the visitor’s name would be submitted to a sex offender data-**  
4 **base check and the school would be alerted if the potential visitor is**  
5 **a registered sex offender; and**

6       **“(c) Examine the possibility of police departments and county**  
7 **sheriffs within this state entering sex offender registration data di-**  
8 **rectly into a Department of State Police database.**

9       **“(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes**  
10 **a quorum for the transaction of business.**

11       **“(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**  
12 **majority of the voting members of the task force.**

13       **“(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**  
14 **chairperson.**

15       **“(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**  
16 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

17       **“(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**  
18 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the**  
19 **task force.**

20       **“(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of**  
21 **the task force.**

22       **“(10) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**  
23 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**  
24 **an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the judi-**  
25 **ciary as appropriate no later than October 1, 2015.**

26       **“(11) The Department of State Police shall provide staff support to**  
27 **the task force.**

28       **“(12) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**  
29 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation, but may be reim-**  
30 **bursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by**

1 them in the performance of their official duties in the manner and  
2 amounts provided for in ORS 292.495. Claims for expenses incurred in  
3 performing functions of the task force shall be paid out of funds ap-  
4 propriated to the Department of State Police for purposes of the task  
5 force.

6 “(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,  
7 are directed to assist the task force in the performance of its duties  
8 and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to  
9 furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force  
10 consider necessary to perform their duties.

11 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2014 Act is repealed on the date of  
12 the convening of the 2016 regular session of the Legislative Assembly  
13 as specified in ORS 171.010.

14 “SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate  
15 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
16 declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.”.

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
