

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1506**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, line 29, delete “the Department of
2 Education” and insert “a local school district”.

3 On page 3, after line 6, insert:

4 “P. ‘State education agency’ means the Department of Education.”.

5 In line 7, delete “P.” and insert “Q.”.

6 In line 9, delete “Q.” and insert “R.”.

7 In line 13, delete “R.” and insert “S.”.

8 In line 16, delete “S.” and insert “T.”.

9 On page 15, after line 34, insert:

“ESTABLISHING NEW STATE COUNCIL

“(Establishment, Duties, Appointment, Term,

Confirmation, Per Diem)

**“SECTION 2. (1) There is established a State Council for Educa-
16 tional Opportunity for Military Children as described in Article VIII
17 of the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military
18 Children under section 1 of this 2014 Act consisting of seven members
19 appointed by the Governor.**

20

**“(2) The term of office of each member is four years, but a member
21 serves at the pleasure of the Governor. Before the expiration of the
22 term of a member, the Governor shall appoint a successor whose term**

1 begins on July 1 next following. A member is eligible for reappoint-
2 ment. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make
3 an appointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired
4 term.

5 “(3) The appointment of a member to the State Council is subject
6 to confirmation by the Senate in the manner prescribed in ORS 171.562
7 and 171.565.

8 “(4) A member of the State Council who is not a member of the
9 Legislative Assembly is entitled to compensation and expenses as pro-
10 vided in ORS 292.495.

11 **“SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding the term of office specified by**
12 **section 2 of this 2014 Act, of the members first appointed to the State**
13 **Council:**

14 “(a) One shall serve for a term ending July 31, 2015.

15 “(b) One shall serve for a term ending July 31, 2016.

16 “(c) One shall serve for a term ending July 31, 2017.

17 “(d) One shall serve for a term ending July 31, 2018.

18 “(2) The State Council shall carry out the duties described in sec-
19 tion 1 of this 2014 Act.

21 “(Qualification of Members)

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23 **“SECTION 4. (1) The members of the State Council for Educational**
24 **Opportunity for Military Children must be residents of this state who**
25 **are well informed on the principles of education of military children.**

26 “(2) The membership must include:

27 “(a) The Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction;

28 “(b) The superintendent of a school district with a high concen-
29 tration of military children;

30 “(c) A representative from a military installation located within

1 **this state;**

2 **“(d) One member from the Senate;**

3 **“(e) One member from the House of Representatives;**

4 **“(f) A representative of the executive branch of the state govern-**
5 **ment; and**

6 **“(g) A representative from the Oregon Military Department.**

7

8 **“(Officers of the State Council, Quorum, Meetings)**

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10 **“SECTION 5. (1) The State Council for Educational Opportunity for**
11 **Military Children shall select one of its members as chairperson and**
12 **another as vice chairperson, for such terms and with duties and pow-**
13 **ers necessary for the performance of the functions of such offices as**
14 **the State Council determines.**

15 **“(2) A majority of the members of the State Council constitutes a**
16 **quorum for the transaction of business.**

17 **“(3) The State Council shall meet at least once every three months**
18 **at a place, day and hour determined by the State Council. The State**
19 **Council may also meet at other times and places specified by the call**
20 **of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the State**
21 **Council.**

23 **“(Employees)**

24

25 **“SECTION 6. (1) The State Council for Educational Opportunity for**
26 **Military Children shall appoint a director to serve at the pleasure of**
27 **the State Council.**

28 **“(2) The designation of the director must be by written order, filed**
29 **with the Secretary of State.**

30 **“(3) Subject to any applicable provisions of ORS chapter 240, the**

1 **director shall appoint all subordinate officers and employees of the**
2 **State Council, prescribe their duties and fix their compensation.**

“(Authority to Adopt Rules)

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6 **“SECTION 7. In accordance with applicable provisions of ORS**
7 **chapter 183, the State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military**
8 **Children may adopt rules necessary for the administration of the laws**
9 **that the State Council is charged with administering.**

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11

“(Oaths, Witnesses, Subpoenas)

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13 **“SECTION 8. The State Council for Educational Opportunity for**
14 **Military Children, the director of the State Council and authorized**
15 **representatives of the State Council may administer oaths, take de-**
16 **positions and issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses**
17 **and the production of documents or other written information neces-**
18 **sary to carry out the provisions of sections 2 to 9 of this 2014 Act. If**
19 **any person fails to comply with a subpoena issued under this section**
20 **or refuses to testify on matters on which the person lawfully may be**
21 **interrogated, the procedure set out in ORS 183.440 shall be followed to**
22 **compel obedience.**

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“(Advisory and Technical Committees)

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26 **“SECTION 9. (1) The State Council for Educational Opportunity for**
27 **Military Children may establish such advisory and technical commit-**
28 **tees as it considers necessary to aid and advise the State Council in**
29 **the performance of its functions. These committees may be continuing**
30 **or temporary committees. The State Council shall determine the rep-**

1 **resentation, membership, terms and organization of the committees**
2 **and shall appoint their members.**

3 **“(2) Members of the committees are not entitled to compensation,**
4 **but at the discretion of the State Council may be reimbursed from**
5 **funds available to the State Council for actual and necessary travel**
6 **and other expenses incurred by them in the performance of their of-**
7 **ficial duties, in the manner and amount provided in ORS 292.495.**

“MISCELLANEOUS

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11 **“SECTION 10. The unit captions used in this 2014 Act are provided**
12 **only for the convenience of the reader and do not become part of the**
13 **statutory law of this state or express any legislative intent in the**
14 **enactment of this 2014 Act.**

15 **“SECTION 11. This 2014 Act is repealed on December 31, 2019.”.**

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
