Subject: -14 Amendment to House Bill 4154

You requested an amendment to House Bill 4154 to "require that Dr. Goldberg come before the legislature's House and Senate Committee on Healthcare, before the end of session, to provide an updated business plan for Cover Oregon moving forward." You specified some of the information that must be contained in the updated business plan.

Your requested amendment accompanies this memo. If passed, the amendment would be effective on passage because the bill already includes an emergency clause. However, it is important to note that if the bill does not pass until the end of session, the Governor has 30 days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, to sign the bill so the amendment could be moot. As you know, the chair of the House Committee on Health Care may request Dr. Goldberg to appear and you may ask the chair to do so. That approach may have fewer pitfalls.

The new temporary section is repealed on March 28, 2014, in the amendment. This goes beyond the constitutional sine die date but allows for possible extensions of the session.
