PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4015

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 10, delete "and".

2 In line 11, delete the period and insert a semicolon.

3 After line 11, insert:

"(e) Is compatible with community, regional and statewide environmental
concerns and available natural resources; and

6 "(f) Is economically, environmentally and socially sustainable and meets 7 the sustainability goals and objectives described in ORS 184.423.".

8 On page 2, after line 10, insert:

9 "(h) Protect Oregon's public health, welfare, safety and environment.".

10 On page 3, after line 5, insert:

"(f) Regional solutions teams shall develop and maintain a list of interested persons and inform those persons of any notices that are required to be given under subsections (5) and (6) of this section and of any other opportunities for public participation in the processes of establishing regional priorities for community and economic development and in considering and recommending regional implementation projects for funding.".

In line 7, delete "five" and insert "seven".

18 In line 15, delete the third "and".

19 In line 16, delete the period and insert a semicolon.

20 After line 16, insert:

"(F) One person who represents a nongovernmental conservation organization; and 1 "(G) One person who represents the citizens of Oregon and community 2 social justice interests.".

3 In line 18, after "(A)" insert "Subject to subsection (5) of this section,".

4 In line 21, after "(C)" insert "Subject to subsection (6) of this section,".

5 After line 26, insert:

(5) A regional solutions advisory committee shall provide public notice 6 and an opportunity for public comment as part of the process of establishing 7 regional priorities for community and economic development. The notice 8 must be given not later than 60 days before the regional solutions advisory 9 committee establishes a regional priority and shall provide links to where 10 the proposed regional priority has been posted on a public website. The 11 website shall include a description of the means and process for providing 12 public comment. The regional solutions advisory committee shall consider 13 all public comments received before establishing a regional priority under 14 this section. 15

(6) In considering and before recommending a regional implementation 16 project proposal for funding, a regional solutions team and regional solutions 17 advisory committee shall provide public notice and an opportunity for public 18 comment as part of the process of considering and recommending a regional 19 implementation project proposal for funding. The notice must be given not 20later than 60 days before the regional solutions team and regional solutions 21advisory committee recommend a regional implementation project proposal 22for funding and shall provide links to where information about the proposed 23regional implementation project has been posted on a public website. The 24website shall include a description of the means and process for providing 25public comment. The regional solutions team and regional solutions advi-26sory committee shall consider all public comments received before recom-27mending a regional implementation project for funding under this section.". 2829
