## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4098

On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 29 through 33 and insert:

"(2)(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 137.370 (2)(a), an offender who has been revoked from a felony probationary sentence in a probation revocation proceeding occurring on or after the effective date of this 2014 Act, and whose sentence was imposed as a downward dispositional departure under the rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, shall receive credit for the time served in jail after arrest and before commencement of the probationary sentence or for the time served in jail as part of the probationary sentence.

"(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 137.370 (2)(a), an offender who has been revoked from a felony probationary sentence in a probation revocation proceeding occurring on or after the effective date of this 2014 Act, and whose sentence was imposed as a presumptive probationary sentence under the rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, shall receive credit for the time served in jail after arrest and before commencement of the probationary sentence or for the time served in jail as part of the probationary sentence, unless the sentencing judge orders otherwise.".
