## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1551

On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 21, insert:

"(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the department determines that a recipient is disqualified under ORS 166.470 from completing the transfer or is otherwise prohibited by state or federal law from possessing a firearm, as soon as practicable the department shall notify the sheriff of the county in which the recipient resides, and, if applicable, the chief of police of the city in which the recipient resides, of the determination.".

On page 5, after line 6, insert:

"(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the department determines that a purchaser is disqualified under ORS 166.470 from completing the purchase or is otherwise prohibited by state or federal law from possessing a firearm, as soon as practicable the department shall notify the sheriff of the county in which the purchaser resides, and, if applicable, the chief of police of the city in which the purchaser resides, of the determination."
