

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1551**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “166.412,” insert “166.422,”.

2 On page 2, after line 21, insert:

3 “(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the department de-
4 termines that a recipient is disqualified under ORS 166.470 (1)(b), (e), (f) or
5 (h) from completing the transfer, as soon as practicable the department shall
6 notify the sheriff of the county in which the recipient is attempting to com-
7 plete the transfer of the firearm, and, if applicable, the chief of police of the
8 city in which the recipient is attempting to complete the transfer of the
9 firearm.”.

10 On page 5, after line 6, insert:

11 “(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the department de-
12 termines that a purchaser is disqualified under ORS 166.470 (1)(b), (e), (f) or
13 (h) from completing the transfer, as soon as practicable the department shall
14 notify the sheriff of the county in which the purchaser is attempting to
15 complete the transfer of the firearm, and, if applicable, the chief of police
16 of the city in which the purchaser is attempting to complete the transfer of
17 the firearm.”.

18 On page 7, after line 23, insert:

19 “**SECTION 10.** ORS 166.422 is amended to read:

20 “166.422. Where appropriate, a person may enforce the legal duties im-
21 posed by ORS 166.412 (7)(a) or (b), by the provisions of ORS 30.260 to 30.300
22 and ORS chapter 183.”.
