

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1559**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “and 471.750” and insert “,  
2 471.750 and 471.805”.

3 On page 11, after line 44, insert:

4 **“SECTION 16. Section 17 of this 2014 Act is added to and made a  
5 part of ORS chapter 471.**

6 **“SECTION 17. (1) In addition to any other fee imposed under this  
7 chapter, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall assess an alco-  
8 hol impact fee on the licensee when a license is issued or renewed. The  
9 commission shall adopt rules establishing an alcohol impact fee for  
10 each type of license issued under this chapter. An alcohol impact fee  
11 for a type of license may not be less than \$39 or more than \$99.**

12 **“(2) The commission shall identify and account for moneys collected  
13 from alcohol impact fees so that the moneys received from licensees  
14 in each county may be distinguished. The commission shall remit the  
15 moneys to the State Treasurer who shall credit the moneys to an ac-  
16 count separate and distinct from the suspense account described in  
17 ORS 471.805 in a manner so that the moneys the commission identifies  
18 with each county may be distinguished.**

19 **“(3) When making payments from the Oregon Liquor Control  
20 Commission Account to a county under ORS 471.810 (1)(c), the State  
21 Treasurer shall also pay to the county out of the account described  
22 under subsection (2) of this section those moneys the commission has**

1 **identified with the county.**

2 **“(4) Moneys paid to a county under this section may be used by the**  
3 **county only for county purposes that address alcohol-related problems,**  
4 **other than criminal prosecutions, which may include, but need not be**  
5 **limited to, purposes involving:**

6 **“(a) The prevention of crimes involving driving a motor vehicle**  
7 **under the influence of intoxicants, the possession of alcohol by a per-**  
8 **son under 21 years of age or the theft of liquor;**

9 **“(b) Alcohol detoxification centers; and**

10 **“(c) The development of alcohol impact areas.**

11 **“(5) If any county declines to receive moneys for the purposes de-**  
12 **scribed in subsection (4) of this section, the moneys shall be divided**  
13 **equally among the other counties.**

14 **“SECTION 18.** ORS 471.805 is amended to read:

15 **“471.805. (1) Except as otherwise provided in ORS 471.810 (2) and section**  
16 **17 of this 2014 Act,** all money collected by the Oregon Liquor Control  
17 Commission under this chapter and ORS chapter 473 and privilege taxes  
18 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer who shall credit it to a suspense  
19 account of the commission. Whenever the commission determines that mon-  
20 eys have been received by it in excess of the amount legally due and payable  
21 to the commission or that it has received money to which it has no legal  
22 interest, or that any license fee or deposit is properly refundable, the com-  
23 mission is authorized and directed to refund such money by check drawn  
24 upon the State Treasurer and charged to the suspense account of the com-  
25 mission. After withholding refundable license fees and such sum, not to ex-  
26 ceed \$250,000, as it considers necessary as a revolving fund for a working  
27 cash balance for the purpose of paying travel expenses, advances, other  
28 miscellaneous bills and extraordinary items which are payable in cash im-  
29 mediately upon presentation, the commission shall direct the State Treasurer  
30 to transfer the money remaining in the suspense account to the Oregon Li-

1 quor Control Commission Account in the General Fund. Moneys in the  
2 Oregon Liquor Control Commission Account are continuously appropriated  
3 to the commission to be distributed and used as required or allowed by law.

4 “(2) All necessary expenditures of the commission incurred in carrying  
5 out the purposes required of the commission by law, including the salaries  
6 of its employees, purchases made by the commission and such sums necessary  
7 to reimburse the \$250,000 revolving fund, shall be audited and paid from the  
8 Oregon Liquor Control Commission Account in the General Fund, upon  
9 warrants drawn by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, pur-  
10 suant to claims duly approved by the commission.”.

11 In line 45, delete “16” and insert “19”.
