

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4110**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, before the period insert  
2 “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 On page 2, line 16, delete “the effective date of this 2014 Act” and insert  
4 “January 1, 2015”.

5 After line 16, insert:

6 **“SECTION 4. The executive director of the Oregon Health Insur-  
7 ance Exchange Corporation shall appear before the House Committee  
8 on Health Care and the Senate Committee on Health Care and Human  
9 Services, prior to March 9, 2014, to present an updated business plan  
10 for the future of the health insurance exchange. The updated business  
11 plan must include, but is not limited to:**

12 **“(1) Demographic information about the individuals who have en-  
13 rolled in qualified health plans through the exchange;**

14 **“(2) The number of individuals enrolled in qualified health plans  
15 through the exchange who have paid premiums, both subsidized and  
16 unsubsidized; and**

17 **“(3) Adjustments to the fees and charges described in ORS 741.105,  
18 or other administrative changes, necessary for the corporation to be  
19 self-sustaining.**

20 **“SECTION 5. Section 2 of this 2014 Act becomes operative January  
21 1, 2015.**

22 **“SECTION 6. Section 4 of this 2014 Act is repealed March 28, 2014.**

1        **SECTION 7. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
2        **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
3        **declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
