- 8 rector shall begin public sales of tickets or shares.] The Oregon State Lottery
- 9 shall be [initiated and shall continue to be] operated so as to produce the
- maximum amount of net revenues to benefit the public purpose described in
- 11 [section 4,] Article XV, section 4, of the Oregon Constitution [of the State
- of Oregon], commensurate with the public good. To achieve this mission,
- in the operation of the Oregon State Lottery, the Oregon State Lottery
- 14 Commission shall balance its obligation to maximize net revenues with
- 15 its obligation to serve the public good through activities and choices
- 16 **that:**
- "(a) Inform users of lottery games of the potential risk for abuse
- 18 of games of chance; and
- 19 "(b) Address and encourage responsible use of lottery games.
- "(2) Other state government departments, boards, commissions, agencies
- 21 and their officers shall cooperate with the lottery commission so as to aid
- 22 the lottery commission in fulfilling these objectives.

- "SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2014 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 461.
- "SECTION 4. (1) For games of chance operated as lottery games, the Oregon State Lottery Commission shall adopt a comprehensive responsible gaming policy. The policy must integrate consideration of responsible playing of games of chance into the operation of the Oregon State Lottery to ensure the integrity, security, honesty and fairness of the lottery games and the associated marketing practices and retail operation of the lottery games.
- "(2) To develop the policy described in subsection (1) of this section, the lottery commission shall engage a diverse group of stakeholders, including Oregon State Lottery employees, lottery game retailers, individuals with expertise in the responsible use of games of chance and individuals with expertise in mental health and addiction issues related to the use of games of chance.
 - "(3) The policy must include:

- "(a) A code of best practices that describes how the lottery commission implements the mission described in ORS 461.200 and provides guidance to Oregon State Lottery employees regarding ethical standards.
- "(b) Procedures to ensure that decision makers consider the best available research on the effects of lottery games and associated marketing activities on vulnerable individuals who struggle with mental health and addiction issues related to the use of games of chance and who may be negatively affected by their use of lottery games.
- "(c) Strategies to minimize the risk of harm to vulnerable individuals from their use of lottery games.
- 29 "(4) Neither the requirement in ORS 461.200 that the Oregon State 30 Lottery achieve the mission of maximizing net revenue commensurate

with the public good nor the requirements of this section: 1

- "(a) Cause the State of Oregon, the Oregon State Lottery, a self-2 supporting agency of the State of Oregon, a lottery contractor or a lottery game retailer to be liable to an individual who has a gambling problem or a gambling addiction, who exhibits symptoms related to problem gambling or gambling addiction or who experiences monetary losses as a result of playing lottery games, or to a family member, dependent or business partner of the individual.
 - "(b) Create a cause of action for liability in favor of an individual who has a gambling problem or a gambling addiction, who exhibits symptoms related to problem gambling or gambling addiction or who experiences monetary losses as a result of playing lottery games, or in favor of a family member, dependent or business partner of the individual.".
