- "[(C)] (c) Notify the Division of Child Support of the Department of Jus-
- 17 tice that a delinquent obligor has won a lottery prize or is entitled to pay-
- 18 ment on a lottery prize.
- "[(c)] (3)(a) If a garnishment proceeding is initiated within the 30-day
- 20 hold period, the lottery commission shall continue to hold any payment to
- 21 the person pending disposition of the proceeding.
- "[(d)] (b) If a garnishment proceeding is not initiated within the 30-day

- 1 hold period, the lottery commission shall make payment on the prize to the
- 2 person at the end of the 30-day hold period or when the division notifies the
- 3 lottery commission that a garnishment proceeding will not be initiated,
- 4 whichever is sooner.

- 5 "[(2)] (4) The lottery commission shall establish and operate a data match
- 6 system using automated data exchanges with the division that identifies de-
- 7 linquent child support obligors. Any information necessary to identify de-
- 8 linquent obligors and hold a payment on a prize shall be available to the
- 9 lottery commission through the data match system.
 - "(5) If the amount of the lottery prize to which a person is entitled exceeds the amount due for delinquent child support obligations that is garnished in accordance with subsection (3)(a) of this section, and if the person has an ongoing child support obligation that remains unsatisfied, the lottery commission shall deliver to the Department of Justice the amount of the lottery prize that exceeds the amount garnished under subsection (3)(a) of this section. The department shall give the person credit for the amount transferred under this subsection and shall apply the credit to the future child support obligation of the person until the credit is fully used.
 - "[(3)] (6) The Department of Justice and the Oregon State Lottery Commission shall enter into an agreement regarding the procedures required by [subsections (1) and (2) of] this section.".
