

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5702**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the first semicolon insert “creating new
2 provisions; amending section 6, chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 10 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$237,000 is established for a six-year period beginning
6 July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fed-
7 eral funds collected or received by the Department of Transportation
8 for public safety broadband planning.**

9 **“SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expendi-
10 tures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (2)(c),
11 chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, for a six-year period beginning July 1,
12 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys
13 or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
14 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon
15 Department of Administrative Services for Public Utility Commission
16 Building exterior replacement is increased by \$2,147,920.**

17 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
18 tation on expenditures established by section 1 (2)(a), chapter 727,
19 Oregon Laws 2013, for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the
20 maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other
21 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery
22 funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Depart-**

1 **ment of Administrative Services for HVAC improvement projects is**
2 **decreased by \$947,920.**

3 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-**
4 **tation on expenditures established by section 1 (2)(g), chapter 727,**
5 **Oregon Laws 2013, for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013, as the**
6 **maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other**
7 **revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery**
8 **funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Depart-**
9 **ment of Administrative Services for Executive Building renovation is**
10 **decreased by \$500,000.**

11 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-**
12 **tation on expenditures established by section 1 (2)(c), chapter 615,**
13 **Oregon Laws 2011, for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as the**
14 **maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other**
15 **revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery**
16 **funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Depart-**
17 **ment of Administrative Services for fire panel upgrades is decreased**
18 **by \$700,000.**

19 **“SECTION 3. Section 6, chapter 727, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to**
20 **read:**

21 **“Sec. 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the fol-
22 **lowing amounts are established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2013,**
23 **as the maximum limit for payment of expenses under this section from bond**
24 **proceeds and other revenues, including federal funds, collected or received**
25 **by the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, for**
26 **the acquisition of and improvements to land and the acquisition, planning,**
27 **constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of buildings and**
28 **facilities at community colleges:**

17 **the amount of \$1,630,000 is established for a six-year period beginning**
18 **July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-**
19 **tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Department of Com-**
20 **munity Colleges and Workforce Development for the Central Oregon**
21 **Community College Cascades Hall termination of Oregon State Uni-**
22 **versity leasehold, reacquisition of unencumbered fee simple ownership,**
23 **and remodel.**

24 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
25 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 1 (3)(a), chapter**
26 **615, Oregon Laws 2011, for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2011, as**
27 **the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or**
28 **other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds,**
29 **but excluding lottery funds, collected or received by the Oregon Mili-**
30 **tary Department for The Dalles Readiness Center is increased by**

1 \$8,000,000.

2 **“SECTION 6. The Legislative Assembly approves the proposal of the**
3 **Oregon Military Department, submitted in accordance with ORS**
4 **396.515 (4), for the sale of the Oregon Military Academy/Regional**
5 **Training Institute building.**

6 **“SECTION 7. The project approval and expenditure limitation es-**
7 **tablished by section 2 (3), chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for the**
8 **Oregon State Police for the Oregon Wireless Interoperability Network**
9 **expires on June 30, 2014.**

10 **“SECTION 8. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate**
11 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
12 **declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
