- Three voting members to be appointed by the Governor of Oregon to serve four year terms (**BLAIR, ERICKSEN, MINTHORN**)
- Three voting members appointed by the Governor of Washington
- Six members from three counties of Washington and three counties of Oregon
- One non-voting member appointed by the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture

**DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:** ORS 196.150

- Perform all functions and responsibilities in accordance with the provisions of the Columbia River Gorge Compact
- Sue and be sued
- Disapprove a county land use ordinance, if the ordinance is inconsistent with management plan provided by federal Act
- Review all proposals for major development action and new residential development in each county within the scenic area (except urban areas) and have the power to disapprove such development if inconsistent with federal Act
- Enact a land use ordinance consistent with the federal Act management plan if the county fails to do so
- Adopt, amend, publish and file bylaws, rules and regulations
