- Seven members (must be Oregon residents) appointed by the Governor to four-year terms:
  - One member representing Clatsop, Columbia, Coos, Curry, Lincoln and Tillamook Counties and those portions of Douglas and Lane Counties lying west of the summit of the Coast Range (CRIBBINS)
  - Two members representing Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington Counties (EBERWEIN, MACPHERSON)
  - One member representing Benton, Linn, Marion, Polk and Yamhill Counties and that portion of Lane County east of the summit of the Coast Range (LIDZ)
  - One member representing Jackson and Josephine Counties and that portion of Douglas County east of the summit of the Coast Range (**LAMB**)
  - One member representing Baker, Crook, Deschutes, Gilliam, Grant, Harney, Hood River, Jefferson, Klamath, Lake, Malheur, Morrow, Sherman, Umatilla, Union, Wallowa, Wasco and Wheeler Counties (**MORROW**)
  - One member representing Benton, Clackamas, Linn, Marion, Multnomah, Polk, Washington and Yamhill Counties and that portion of Lane County lying east of the summit of the Coast Range (MCARTHUR)
- At least one member shall be or have been an elected city official (), and at least one member shall be an elected county official at the time of appointment (CRIBBINS)
- Members can serve no more than two full terms; can be removed by the Governor for cause

**DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:** ORS 197.035, 197.040, 197.628, 197.629

- Direct the performance by the Director of Dept. of Land Conservation and Development
- Adopt rules, and adopt by rule any statewide land use policies
- Adopt and amend land use goals
- Review comprehensive plans for compliance with land use goals
- Coordinate planning efforts of state agencies
- Insure widespread citizen involvement in all phases
- Review and recommend areas of critical concern to Legislative Assembly
- Apply for and receive moneys from federal government and State of Oregon
- Assist in development and preparation of model land use regulations to guide state agencies, and local governments in implementing goals
- Establish and maintain a schedule for periodic review of comprehensive plans and land use regulations
- Concentrate periodic review assistance to local governments on achieving compliance with statewide land use laws and goals that address economic development, needed housing, transportation, public facilities and services, and urbanization.
