DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: **ORS 184.615 to 184.619, ORS 366.205**

- General supervision and control over all matters related to selection, establishment, construction, improvement and maintenance of state highways
- Prepare state transportation policy and comprehensive long range plan for a safe multi-modal transportation system
- Adopt policies relating to coordination and administration of programs relating to highways, motor vehicles, public transit, transportation and the Maritime Pilots Board
- Adopt policies and rules governing divisions of the Department of Transportation consistent with ORS 184.610 to 184.647
- Meet at least once per month
- Give priority to projects that enhance the safety of the users of highways
