- Seven members appointed by the Governor to three-year terms including:
  - Five chiropractors who must have practiced chiropractic in this state for five years prior to appointment (BJORNSON, **KOUZES**, ROMANICK, **VERMILLION**, **YOUNG**)
  - Two public members who are residents of the state (REED, TAYLOR)
- Upon sufficient proof of inability or misconduct to Governor, member must be dismissed

**DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:**                    **ORS 684.150- 684.185**

- Enforce and exercise supervision over the practice of chiropractic within this state
- Adopt rules for the administration of ORS chapter 684
- Adopt schedule of minimum educational requirements
- Upon receipt of a complaint, investigate, take affidavits, summon witnesses, require evidence production and take testimony
- Establish standards and tests to determine qualifications of chiropractic license applicants
- Issue, deny, suspend and revoke licenses; enjoin persons practicing in violation
- Determine acceptable chiropractic schools, colleges, institutions, and training
- Prescribe time, place, method, manner, scope and subjects of examinations
- Appoint peer review committees to evaluate complaints against chiropractic physicians
- Enter into contracts to make services available to impaired chiropractic physicians and adopt rules for the administration of a diversion program
