**APPOINTMENT/CONFIRMATION AUTHORITY:** ORS 689.115

**TERM:** Four-year terms: July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2020

**ECONOMIC INTEREST FILING (ORS 244.050):** Not required.

**STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS:** ORS 689.115 and 689.125

Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- Nine members:
  - Five licensed pharmacists (DEBARMORE, JAMES, LINARES, REHER, WELLS)
  - Two pharmacy technicians (ARMSTRONG, VIPPERMAN)
  - Two representatives of the public (ANDERSON, CHUTE)
- Pharmacist members shall be residents of the state, licensed and in good standing, engaged in practice and have five years of experience in Oregon
- Public members shall be residents who are 18 years of age; have not or ever been a pharmacist or spouse of pharmacist; have no financial interest in pharmacy services and have not engaged in any activity directly related to the practice of pharmacy
- Members serve four-year terms and no more than two full terms; members appointed to fill vacancy may serve two full terms plus unexpired term
- Members can be removed by the Governor for cause

**DUTIES AND AUTHORITY:** ORS 689.135-689.185

- Generally regulate practice of pharmacy, drug outlets and the manufacture, production, sale or distribution of drugs, medicines
- Adopt rules
- Determine and set licensing fees
- Receive and expend funds in addition to biennial appropriation
- Circulate annually any changes in laws relating to pharmacy, controlled substances, drugs and poisons and the rules adopted to enforce such laws
- Appoint advisory committees; join professional organizations and associations
- Assign uniform state numbers to drug outlets
- Investigate and collect evidence of alleged violations; enforce regulations; administer oaths, issue notices and subpoenas, hold hearings and perform other acts reasonably necessary
- Elect president and vice president of the board; employ executive director
- Meet at least once every three months
