APPOINTMENT/CONFIRMATION AUTHORITY: ORS 660.321

TERM: Three-year terms: June 1, 2016 – May 31, 2019

ECONOMIC INTEREST FILING (ORS 244.050): Not required.

STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS: ORS 660.321

Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- A State Workforce Investment Board shall be created under section 2821(b) and (c) of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 to assist in the development of the State Unified Workforce Plan established under ORS 660.324 and to carry out the other functions described by the federal Act.
- Membership of the board shall be in accordance with the requirements of section 2821(b) of the federal Act.
- Representatives of business described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act who are appointed to the board shall be subject to Senate confirmation.
- Governor selects the chairperson according to 2821(c) of the federal Act.
- A majority of the board shall re representatives of business, as described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act.
- Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the board are nonvoting members of the boards and may act in an advisory capacity only.
- To transact business at a meeting of the board, a quorum of voting members must participate. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the voting members. At least 25 percent of the members participating shall be representative of business, as described in section 2821(b)(1)(C)(i) of the federal Act.
- Members are:
 - Two members of the Senate appointed by the Senate President (GEORGE, ROSENBAUM)
 - Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker (HOLVEY, HUFFMAN)
 - Business representative positions (BOLKEN, BROWN, CHAFFEE, DULL, **DUNN**, FALLT, GEORGE, GUTZLER, HALLIGAN, HOPEWELL, LUCHAK, MADDEN, **O’NEILL**, RODRIGUEZ, WALL, WEBER)
 - Chief elected officials (a county commissioner, county judge or the mayor of the City of Portland) (BROWN)
 - Labor organization representatives, nominated by a state labor federation (BAKER, BYRD, KING)
 - Representatives of individuals or organizations that have experience with youth activities (HELZERMAN)

- Representatives of individuals or organizations with experience and expertise in delivery of workforce investment activities, including chief executive officers of community colleges or community-based organizations (ROBERTS)
- Serving by position: Governor (BROWN); Commissioner for Community College Services (PREUS)
- Additional member representing elected officials, labor organizations or youth activities
- Additional members can be appointed by the Governor if required to comply with federal law

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: ORS 660.324

- Develop and submit to the Governor, a single, unified state plan that outlines a strategy with quantitative goals, for the statewide workforce investment system for the State of Oregon in accordance with section 2821 of the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998. Upon the Governor's approval of the state plan, the Governor shall cause the State Unified Workforce Plan to be delivered to the Legislative Assembly.
- The board shall develop and include in the state plan goals designed to promote Oregonians' self-sufficiency.
- Assist Governor in:
 - Developing Oregon's workforce investment system
 - Ensuring timely consultation and collaboration with chief elected officials, local workforce investment boards and other workforce stakeholders,
 - Reviewing local workforce plans
 - Complying with provisions of the federal Act
