Oregon Opportunity Network (Oregon ON) is a nonprofit statewide association of affordable housing and community development organizations. Our members are mission-driven nonprofits with decades of expertise and a core commitment to housing vulnerable Oregonians – including families, seniors, and people with disabilities – who the market does not serve. Our members provide services and housing across the continuum of needs from homelessness, to multifamily rental housing, to homeownership.

Our members also provide an array of programs to support the success of residents, including after-school and summer support for children, financial literacy, homeownership education, Individual Development Accounts, wellness, employment, microenterprise, and much more. We know what works to end the cycle of poverty.

While Oregon ON's 2017 legislative agenda is still under development, it will include an array of resource asks and policy proposals to address the statewide housing crisis. We need the Legislature's support to accelerate our efforts to ensure that every Oregonian has a safe, stable place to call home.

Oregon ON hosts an annual Legislative Lunch in the building for legislators and their staff – please save the date for January 11. We are members of the Housing Alliance and work closely with them in Salem each session, as well as advocating at the local, regional and federal levels for housing opportunity. We're proud to be part of the Tenant Protections coalition and also helped lead the Inclusionary Zoning Coalition in the 2016 session.
