#### Public Hearing

HB 2589

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Requires State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules prohibiting application of pesticide products containing nitro-group neonicotinoids.

HB 3428

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Creates special certification requirements for pesticide applicators and public applicators who spray or otherwise apply pesticides by aircraft.

HB 3123

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Prohibits application of pesticide by aircraft except under terms and conditions of pest emergency declaration issued by State Department of Agriculture or State Forestry Department.

HB 3434 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Appropriates moneys to State Department of Agriculture for biennium beginning July 1, 2015, to administer performance of Pesticide Analytical and Response Center duties.

HB 3429

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Requires governing board of Pesticide Analytical and Response Center to adopt rules establishing standardized operating procedures for state agencies represented on governing board to receive and investigate complaints regarding use of pesticides.

HB 3430

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Requires State Department of Agriculture to establish telephone line for persons concerned about misuse or alleged misuse of pesticides.

- HB 3482  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-26-2015 MEETING: Requires state agency or local government to keep records of pesticide applications made by public applicator or public trainee employed by state agency or local government.
- HB 2183  
Requires person growing *Arundo donax* L. for commercial purposes to file bond with Invasive Species Council.
- HB 2984  
Requires Clackamas County to develop pilot program for forestry products grown on nonforest land in county to be commercially produced and marketed through forestry product cooperative.
- HB 2985  
Authorizes counties to establish programs for forestry products grown on nonforest lands in counties to be commercially produced and marketed through forestry product cooperatives.

**Work Session**

- HB 2474  
Prohibits veterinary facility from offering services related to practice of veterinary medicine, surgery or dentistry unless veterinary facility registers with Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board.
- HB 2687  
Provides exception to offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle for persons operating farm vehicle.
- HB 2184  
Directs Department of Transportation and State Parks and Recreation Department to provide link from Department of Transportation website to State Parks and Recreation Department website to provide information about how to purchase day-use parking passes.
- HB 2537  
Increases damages for unlawful taking or killing of wildlife.
