HB 2183

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-31-2015 AGENDA: Requires person growing Arundo donax L. for commercial purposes to file bond with Invasive Species Council.

HB 3089

Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to conduct study on increasing local revenues from mining operations and present report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on or before September 15, 2016.

HB 3090

Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to conduct study on consolidating permit processes for mining and present report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on or before September 15, 2016.

HB 3096

Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to conduct study of mineral resource potential in Oregon and present report to Legislative Assembly by February 1 of each odd-numbered year.

HB 3269

Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to conduct study of mineral resource potential in Oregon and present report to Legislative Assembly.

HB 2474

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-31-2015 AGENDA: Prohibits veterinary facility from offering services related to practice of veterinary medicine, surgery or dentistry unless veterinary facility registers with Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board.

HB 2687

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-31-2015 AGENDA: Provides exception to offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle for persons operating farm vehicle.

HB 2184

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-31-2015 AGENDA: Directs Department of Transportation and State Parks and Recreation Department to provide link from Department of Transportation website to State Parks and Recreation Department website to provide information about how to purchase day-use parking passes.

HB 2537

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3-31-2015 AGENDA: Increases damages for unlawful taking or killing of wildlife.

HB 2653

Requires State Department of Agriculture to establish standards for locating apiaries in residential zones in Oregon.

HB 2209 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates Task Force on Shellfish.

HB 3334 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board to spend \$2 million per year out of Flexible Incentives Account on implementation of strategies to protect and restore sage grouse habitat.
