Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2668

- Repeals statutes requiring industrial hemp growers and handlers to be licensed by State Department of Agriculture. HB 2183
- Requires person growing Arundo donax L. for commercial purposes to file bond with Invasive Species Council. HB 3272

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to conduct study to determine forestland wildfire and timber harvesting effects on business activities and on economic development efforts.

HB 3210

Requires that annual timber harvest on state forestlands in each subject forest district equal, at minimum, specified percentage of annual amount of harvestable timber expected to be grown on state forestlands in district.
