#### **Work Session**

HB 2984

Requires Clackamas County to develop pilot program for forestry products grown on nonforest land in county to be commercially produced and marketed through forestry product cooperative.

Authorizes counties to establish programs for forestry products grown on nonforest lands in counties to be commercially produced and marketed through forestry product cooperatives.

HB 3435

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-7-2015 AGENDA: Authorizes State Department of Agriculture to require person holding or applying for license to engage in seed transactions for commercial purposes to report grass seed supply information.

HB 3459

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4-7-2015 AGENDA: Increases frequency of days for which State Fish and Wildlife Commission may authorize persons to angle for fish or take shellfish without licenses or tags.

### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

HB 2668

Repeals statutes requiring industrial hemp growers and handlers to be licensed by State Department of Agriculture.

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to conduct study to determine forestland wildfire and timber harvesting effects on business activities and on economic development efforts.

HB 3210

Requires that annual timber harvest on state forestlands in each subject forest district equal, at minimum, specified percentage of annual amount of harvestable timber expected to be grown on state forestlands in district.
