Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing

HB 2386

Authorizes Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to issue temporary cease and desist order under certain circumstances.

HB 2387

Authorizes Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to administratively compel provision of bond by certain employers.

HB 2212

Authorizes imposition of civil penalty against employer that fails to pay wages owing to employee on regular payday.

HB 2007

Makes imposition of disciplinary action against employee that inquires about or discloses wage information unlawful employment practice.

HB 2006

Makes practice of paying employees of opposite sex who hold equivalent jobs at different wage rates unlawful employment practice.
