HB 2090 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes task force to study relationship between large employers and their employees who are receiving public assistance and to make recommendations regarding feasibility of imposing fee to offset shifting of expenses to public assistance.

HB 3471

Imposes fee on certain large employers who pay employees less than specified amount.

HB 3325

Allows employers to deduct value of certain benefits from minimum wage to be paid employees.

HB 3495

Provides for employer and employee contributions to pension program and individual account program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan to first be made for new members for wages that are attributable to services performed during first full pay period following six-month probationary period, without regard to when wages are considered earned for other purposes.

HB 3059

Requires Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to establish toll-free telephone hotline to receive inquiries related to employment status of persons who perform live entertainment.
