Work Session

HB 2471

Changes qualifications to practice as funeral service practitioner or embalmer in this state, including qualifications related to reciprocity and apprenticeship.

HB 2472

Modifies authority of State Mortuary and Cemetery Board to conduct investigations of premises and records of facilities that provide services related to final disposition of human remains.

HB 3242

Permits State Mortuary and Cemetery Board to assume control of insolvent, bankrupt or disowned cemetery to carry out existing prearrangement sales contracts to which cemetery is party and to effect rights of plot owners.

HB 3243

Permits funeral establishment to take custody of unclaimed body of indigent person.

HB 2469

Establishes requirements for certain insurers to conduct own risk and solvency assessment and to file report of assessment with Department of Consumer and Business Services.

HB 2565

Makes Oregon State Bar subject to public employees collective bargaining law.

HB 2594

Requires insurer of liable party to pay actual costs of emergency response by private emergency responders.

HB 2958

Provides that limited license that rental company obtains to sell insurance in connection with renting vehicles also extends to rental company's employees and designated agents.

HB 3186

Deletes language prohibiting advertising or promoting outdoor mass gathering without permit.

HB 3236

Limits enforceability of noncompetition agreement to one year.

HB 3419

Prohibits financial institution from using broker price opinion to value real property or interest in real property in certain circumstances.

HB 3508

Provides that unemployment insurance benefits are payable during summer term to community college instructor who has received assignment for previous summer term.

HB 3488

Exempts specified instruments that condition transfer of fee simple interest in real property from prohibition on fee, commission or other payment to declarant or other person upon transfer of interest in real property.
