Work Session

- HB 2386 A
Authorizes Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to issue temporary cease and desist order under certain circumstances.
- HB 2577
Makes legislative finding regarding benefit of state building code requiring that new construction of certain parking facilities include electrical supply capacity and conduit system capable of supporting electric vehicle charging.
- HB 2836
Provides hours of service credit for vesting purposes and retirement credit to member of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan who receives workers' compensation disability payments and later returns to employment with participating public employer.
- HB 3025
Establishes unlawful employment practice related to misuse of information about criminal charges and convictions of applicant for employment.
- HB 3097
Makes inquiring after applicant's conviction history and certain activities related to conducting criminal records check on prospective employee unlawful employment practice.
- HB 3058
Permits Public Employee Retirement System member who is retired to be employed by school district or education service district as teacher of career and technical education without loss of retirement benefits.
- HB 3137
Creates unlawful employment practice of requiring employee to create, file or sign documents containing false information related to hours worked or compensation received by employee or retaliating against employee for refusal to do so.
- HB 3162 **
Establishes Task Force on Franchisees to study relationships among franchisors, subfranchisors and franchisees to determine whether, for purposes of applying this state's tax laws and other laws, franchisee or subfranchisor is employee of franchisor.

- HB 3195
Provides that owner of abutting real property may not be required to maintain or repair sidewalks or curbs, and no lien for assessment for repairs may attach to abutting real property, if abutting real property does not have direct access to sidewalks or curbs.
- HB 3244
Provides that borrower or borrower's agent may rely on lender's payoff statement for amount required to discharge mortgage or perform obligation necessary to request reconveyance of estate of real property described in trust deed unless lender delivers amended payoff statement.
- HB 3304
Eliminates examination and experience requirements for licensing as landscape construction professional.
- HB 3325
Allows employers to deduct value of certain benefits from minimum wage to be paid employees.
- HB 3480
Declares importance of enhancing trade opportunities vital to economic interest of Oregon through labor peace at Port of Portland.
- HB 3243
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2015 AGENDA: Permits funeral establishment to take custody of unclaimed body of indigent person.
- HB 2469
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2015 AGENDA: Establishes requirements for certain insurers to conduct own risk and solvency assessment and to file report of assessment with Department of Consumer and Business Services.
- HB 2565
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2015 AGENDA: Makes Oregon State Bar subject to public employees collective bargaining law.
- HB 2764
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2015 AGENDA: Modifies circumstances under which attorney fees may be awarded and amount of attorney fees awarded in workers' compensation claims.
- HB 3508
CARRIED OVER FROM 4/15/2015 AGENDA: Provides that unemployment insurance benefits are payable during summer term to community college instructor who has received assignment for previous summer term.
