SB 574 A

Requires person providing restoration work on residential or small commercial structure following man-made or natural disaster to have appropriate license endorsement issued by Construction Contractors Board.

SB 693 A

Authorizes scrap metal business to make payment by electronic funds transfer, stored value card or stored value device.

SB 699

Broadens exemption to provisions regulating cosmetology disciplines for persons who prepare individual's hair solely for professional photograph or theatrical performance.

SB 291 A

Modifies circumstances under which injured state worker has right to reinstatement or reemployment with employer at injury.

SB 371

Allows insurer or self-insured employer to mail notice of closure of workers' compensation claim to beneficiaries of deceased worker under certain circumstances.
