#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 380 A

Makes certain actions based on complaints filed with Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries discretionary on part of commissioner.

#### Work Session

SB 137 A

Changes definition of public works for purpose of applying prevailing rate of wage to include project that uses \$750,000 or more of funds of public agency for constructing, reconstructing, painting or performing major renovation on road, highway, building, structure or improvement of any type.

SB 297 A

Revises qualifications for registration to practice professional engineering, land surveying or photogrammetric mapping.

SB 462 A

Provides that record is effective as financing statement if record satisfies requirements for financing statement and sufficiently provides name of debtor.

SB 470 A

For purposes of unemployment insurance benefits, provides that certain individuals who perform services in other than instructional, research or principal administrative capacity for educational institutions and who terminate employee-employer relationship for good cause do not have reasonable assurance of performing services for that employer in subsequent academic year or term.

SB 488 A

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Establishes uniform standards for hand dryers installed in public restrooms, including standards that impose limit on decibel level of operating hand dryer.

SB 578

Permits insurer, under specified conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website in lieu of mailing or delivering insurance policy and endorsements to insured.

**June 1, 2015**

- SB 580 A  
Allows State Landscape Contractors Board to assess arbitration or contested case proceeding costs to person requesting that claim filed against board licensee be resolved through arbitration or contested case proceeding.
- SB 583 A  
Allows brewery-public house licensee to also hold interest in off-premises sales licensee.
- SB 699  
Broadens exemption to provisions regulating cosmetology disciplines for persons who prepare individual's hair solely for professional photograph or theatrical performance.
- SB 715  
Permits travel retailers that are not licensed insurance producers to offer travel insurance at direction of licensed insurance producers, subject to certain restrictions.
- SB 879 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Exempts attorney who negotiates terms of residential mortgage loan in attorney's representation of client that buys or sells dwelling unit from requirement to obtain mortgage loan originator's license in order to perform activities of mortgage loan originator.
- SB 934 A  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5/27: Makes limitation on state liability for nonproperty claims applicable to State Fair Council.
