HB 2578

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/5/2015 AGENDA: Requires telecommunications contract between telecommunications utility and residential customer to allow customer to terminate contract without penalty if customer enters hospice program.

HB 2637

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/5/2015 AGENDA: Provides that material misrepresentations in commercial communications about mortgage credit products constitutes unlawful trade practice.

HB 2716

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/5/2015 AGENDA: Requires contracting agencies to provide as material condition of public contract that contractor remain certified as disadvantaged, minority, women or emerging small business enterprise during entire term of public contract if contracting agency awarded public contract, in whole or in part, on basis of contractor's certification.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2132

Allows county that collects forest protection district assessment or surcharge to retain percentage of collected moneys for purpose of paying county administrative costs.

HB 2528 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes Task Force on Citizen Review of Public Works Projects.

HB 2850

Provides that notice of insurance policy's lapse is not effective unless insurer sends written notice to policy owner at least 25 days before date of lapse and includes explanation of reasons for lapse.

HB 3052

Requires contract for public improvement to provide that contractor use biodegradable lubricant in contractor's operations related to public improvement and that contractor have similar requirement in contractor's subcontracts.

HB 3062

Exempts prepaid transportation cards from Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act and related statutes.
