CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Expands membership of Oregon Government Ethics Commission from seven members to nine members on July 1, 2016.
- HB 2252
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Establishes requirements under which debt buyer may bring legal action to collect debt.
- HB 2599
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Prohibits public utility from terminating electric or natural gas service to certain residential customers under certain circumstances.
- HB 2617
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/16/2015 AGENDA: Provides that contractor may award subcontract only to responsible subcontractor.
- HB 3248
