Public Hearing

HB 2655

Directs State Board of Education to adopt specified standards related to student education records.

HB 2680

Prohibits use of results of statewide summative assessment developed by state-led consortium to establish summative ratings of schools or to make summative evaluations of teachers or administrators.

HB 2713

Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation of use of standardized tests in public schools in this state. HB 2714

Provides that parents have right to excuse student from statewide assessment and that school districts must provide notice of that right to parents.

HB 2715

Prohibits school district employee or volunteer from posting, publishing or making publicly available personally identifiable information in relation to results of performance-based assessment.
