Public Hearing

HB 2709

Directs State Board of Education to adopt standards for rights of parents, legal guardians and students relating to student education records.

HB 2710

Directs Department of Education to issue privacy risk assessment of any data system, program or contract involving student education records.

HB 2711

Establishes standards relating to personal identifying information that State Board of Education must follow when adopting rules related to student education records.

HB 2712

Directs State Board of Education to adopt schedule of civil penalties for violations of rules related to creation, use, custody and disclosure, including access, of student education records.
