Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

HB 2404

Adjusts school food and beverage nutritional standards to comply with federal food and beverage nutritional standards.

HB 2602

Modifies criteria to qualify for grant to be used to provide instructional time during summer program.

HB 2650

Directs State Library to distribute grants to school districts for early reading programs provided during summer.

Public Hearing

HB 2608

Adds two members to Oregon Education Investment Board to represent school district boards and parents. HB 2766

Provides that language-based computer coding may satisfy any world language requirements in public schools and second language requirements in community colleges and post-secondary institutions of education.

HB 2928 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Class Sizes to determine appropriate class sizes of students, identify methods to reduce

class sizes and determine cost for methods to reduce class sizes.
