HB 2597

Directs school district director for special education to evaluate child to determine if child has disability and if truancy or unexcused absence is manifestation of disability, if requested by parent or child has not been evaluated within previous 12 months.

HB 2657 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Directs State Board of Education to not consider days pupil is absent when determining aggregate days membership for purposes of distributions from State School Fund.

HB 2673

Requires school district to prepare annual summary that describes special education and related services provided by school district during previous school year.
