HB 3363

Prohibits school district from allowing certain promotional activities for food or beverage items that do not meet minimum nutritional standards.

Directs State Board of Education to not consider days pupil is absent when determining aggregate days membership for purposes of distributions from State School Fund.

HB 3069

Requires teacher education institutions and teacher education programs to provide applicants with training related to teaching and testing reading as condition of being approved.

HB 3166

Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to establish standards that allow certain persons to teach noncore courses.

HB 3319

Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to reduce dropout rates.
