HB 3072

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2015: Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to improve effectiveness of public education for kindergarten through grade 12.

HB 3363

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2015: Prohibits school district from allowing certain promotional activities for food or beverage items that do not meet minimum nutritional standards.

HB 3536

Prohibits State Board of Education from adopting rules or imposing sanctions related to use of mascots by public schools.

HB 3071

Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to improve effectiveness of curriculum of public schools.

HB 3073

Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to improve effectiveness of statewide assessments.

HB 3074

Directs Department of Education to evaluate methods to improve ability of student to attend school in school district in which student is not resident.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2015: Directs Department of Education to develop and implement statewide education plan for educationally disadvantaged youth.

HB 3166

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2015: Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to establish standards that allow certain persons to teach noncore courses.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2015: Establishes Oregon Quality Education Model Modernization Task Force.

- HB 2712  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/17/2015: Directs State Board of Education to adopt schedule of civil penalties for violations of rules related to creation, use, custody and disclosure, including access, of student education records.
- HB 3384 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Creates income tax credit for unreimbursed expenses of teachers and adjunct instructors.
- HB 3493 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Provides that Superintendent of Public Instruction and State Board of Education may not make or authorize certain calculations related to aggregate days membership and weighted average daily membership except as specified by statute.
- HB 3339  
Transfers Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to Department of Education.
- HB 2967 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue  
Directs school districts to prepare and file annual reports related to students enrolled in English as second language program.
- HB 2673  
Requires school district to prepare annual summary that describes special education and related services provided by school district during previous school year.
